Who can register? Anyone at least 21 years of age, looking to increase their chances for better employment opportunities. What do I need to bring for registration?

A valid form of photo identification:

- DMV driver's license
- DMV Non driver's license
- Nassau County Parks Leisure Pass
- Passports from your country of origin.

How long is the registration process?

ESL registration time ranges between 3-4 hours depending on the student.

Testing begins promptly at the scheduled time. Students will be re-scheduled for the next available testing day if he/she arrives 5 minutes after the scheduled time. Registration includes the following:

- Interview with a teacher to complete an application
- English speaking and listening assessment; reading and writing assessment
- Writing sample and further testing assessments
- Review student contract and program policy/procedure .
